### BSP Remittance for period 1-8 March due on 17<sup>th</sup> March now deferred to 20<sup>th</sup> March

We had contacted the national carrier regarding the request made by IATA Agents Association of Sri Lanka for deferral of Remittance from 17<sup>th</sup> March. We have been made to understand that UL and LCAG are agreeable for Remittance to be deferred till 20<sup>th</sup> March 2020.

However, we understand majority of the Agents have already submitted the cheques to the courier, which have been presented for clearing today. For those Agents who had not submitted the cheques or had their cheques returned, cheques will have to be deposited or electronically transferred to the Deutsche Bank account on 20<sup>th</sup> March.

Please note that there will be no change to the Remittance for period 9<sup>th</sup>-15<sup>th</sup> March on 23<sup>rd</sup> March.
