



# BRIEF ON THE CHANGES TO THE IMPORTS AND EXPORTS (CONTROL) ACT NO.1 OF 1969 IN JULY 2023

#### INTRODUCTION

This is the 16<sup>th</sup> brief in a series that analyzes the amendments to the Imports and Exports (Control) Act regulations. These briefs have been prepared and published since April 2020<sup>1</sup> to provide clarity and awareness of the changes to the Import and Export Regulations. This brief analyses the Gazette dated July 20<sup>th</sup>, 2023.

## **KEY TAKEAWAYS**

- Gazette removed the Temporary Suspension of 327 HS codes. Most of these restrictions were removed from stone and glass products, textiles, vegetables, and miscellaneous products such as furniture and fittings.
- A total of 2207 items as of July 20<sup>th</sup>, 2023, are under TS, Import Control License (ICL), Suspended ICL (SL), and Banned (B) restrictions. This is about 28% of the total tariff lines. Most restrictions are in the Transportation sector (33%), Chemical and Allied industries (21%), and Textile (18%).

## **KEY CHANGES OBSERVED**

The Gazette amended Gazette Extraordinary No. 2312/78 dated January 01<sup>st</sup>, 2023, which was further amended in Gazette Extraordinary No. 2335/26 dated June 09<sup>th</sup>, 2023. This July 2023 Gazette removed 124 HS codes from List A and 203 HS codes from List B<sup>2</sup> (as shown in Table 01).

The Gazette allowed Customs to release cargo related to the above products that arrived at the Port/Airport of Sri Lanka from April 16<sup>th</sup>, 2020, to July 9<sup>th</sup>, 2023, violating the import control rules subject to payment of an Additional Fee of 15% of the CIF Value of such goods to the Controller General of Import and Export Control.

The Gazette made further changes to regulation no. 8 (h)(i) of Gazette Extraordinary No. 2312/78 dated January 01<sup>st</sup>, 2023 applying the regulation for tiles under HS heading 69.07. A comparison of this regulation change from the January 2023 Gazette to this latest Gazette is given below.

The Gazette also made amendments to Gazette Extraordinary No. 2326/41 dated April 6<sup>th</sup>, 2023. This provided an exemption to import of single-use plastic plates, cups, spoons, forks, knives, and other cutlery instruments, classified under the HS Code of 3924.10.90, by a registered catering service provider for the purpose of servicing passengers on-board of international airlines, subject to prior approval of the Controller General of Imports and Exports.

## **OVERVIEW OF THE SECTOR IMPLICATIONS**

Observing the overall restrictions (TS, ICL, SL, and Banned) in sectors placed by Gazettes on import controls, most restrictions are in the Transportation sector (33%), Chemical and Allied industries (21%), and Textile (18%).
