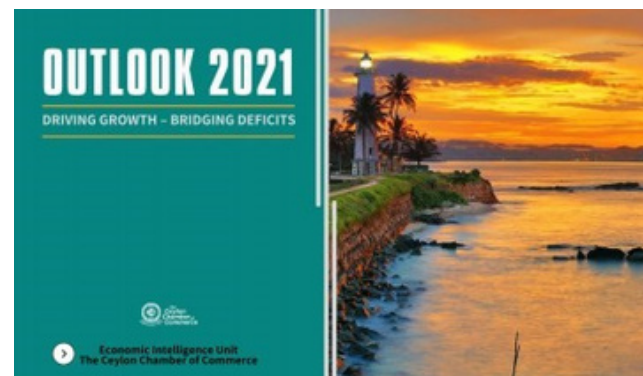

- Food Advisory Committee proposed zero trans-fat levels in foods. Steering Committee participated in a stakeholder consultation and strongly lobbied for Codex value, following which an agreement for 2% TFA, which is the Codex level, is in place
- Supported Chamber interventions during the ban of items under imports and export control regulations
- Submissions on Proposed Fortifications and Extraction Rate for Wheat Flour under the Draft Food (Cereals Pulses and Legumes) Regulations – 2020
- Letter sent to Secretary of the Treasury requesting the lifting of the suspension of palm oil importation
- Following lobbying against the Food Advisory Committee proposal to introduce European Union level for Aflatoxin(0.05 ppb) in milk, Codex level (0.5 ppb) is now finalised as the level for Sri Lanka.
- Participated in stakeholder consultation on Draft Food (Mycotoxin) Regulations and a written submission was made on aflatoxins in food

- Food & Beverage Steering Committee chair participated in the meeting conducted by Imports and Exports Control Department and made a joint submission with Importers Association to address the current concerns in import inspection scheme conducted by SLC and SLSI
- Joint Submission with Food & Beverage Steering Committee, and Cosmetics & Pharmaceuticals Steering Committee on Gazette Nos. 2211/50 and 2211/51 requiring plastic packaging to have an identification code printed, and planned list of plastic items to be banned. Lack of a date of enforcement meant regulations could be enforced from the date of the Gazette. Following strong lobbying, resolutions achieved include CEA agreeing not to prosecute companies for non-compliance until 2022, agreeing to create a guideline on implementation of regulations, and the proposed list of banned plastic postponed to January 2023.
