Recognising Excellence in Sustainable Projects

The Best Projects Sustainability Awards, initiated in 2007 under the Best Corporate Citizen Sustainability Awards by The Ceylon Chamber of Commerce, honour impactful sustainability initiatives by public and private sector organisations.

The Awards showcase projects that address key sustainability pillars economic, environmental, social, and governance - whether integrated into core operations or extending beyond. From climate action and education to community upliftment and ethical governance, these efforts reflect a strong commitment to people and planet.



SURMISSION OF APPLICATIONS

All private and public companies listed/unlisted, Government undertakings/institutions are eligible to apply. Holding companies should provide a list of all their subsidiaries and the application should cover details pertaining

to all subsidiaries.

Applications should be submitted through the online platform, together with supporting documents. The applicants should provide information requested and relating to all aspects of sustainability Footnament, and Social - to be eligible for the Rest Comparing Chira-Sustainability Award.

EVALUATION

In evaluating the applications, all questions addressed in the application will be considered. An independent Evaluation Panel will scrutinize the applications as per a predetermined marking scheme under each area as illustrated in the quildance document.

The short-listed applicants will be called upon to make a brief presentation and face an interview with the Panel of Judges and Panel of Evaluators which will also carry marks. The CEO and the Sustainability Manager should represent the company at the filind interview. The decisions of the Feducation Panel and the Judges will be filind and binding upon all applicants. The Ceylon Chamber of Commerce may opt to use a digital platform for the interview process based on the challenges forced at the time of the final Interviews.
